TIPS FOR AN ENJOYABLE DAY OF WINE TASTING

- 1) Please arrive at least 15 minutes early for check-in and a short lesson about the many steps to tasting wine. Most tours will depart promptly at 11:00 a.m. Return times vary but most tour groups return to the point of origination by 5:00 p.m. We encourage you to confirm starting and ending times and point of origination for your particular tour.
- 2) Touring itineraries may include walking through a winery and the areas where grapes are processed and stored, or walking through a vineyard. Each tour is unique in the types of areas you may visit. Keeping that in mind we suggest you wear clothing and shoes that are appropriate to the activity and the weather – closed toe, flat shoes and casual, comfortable clothing are usually best.
- 3) Most wineries can accommodate people with special needs. Please let us know what your requirements are when you book your reservation.
- 4) The type of transportation provided is based on the number of people going on a tour. It may be a van, mid-sized bus or full motor coach that you will be entering and exiting at each stop of the tour.
- 5) On any given day of touring you may taste as many as 15 or more wines. Wineries generally pour each person one to two ounces of each wine. While you may opt not to drink all of the wine poured, that can amount to a considerable amount of wine consumed. Keeping that in mind, we encourage you to have a hearty breakfast that morning. You may also want to bring a bottle of water.
- 6) Lunch will be served at one of the wineries, outside if weather permits. If you have dietary restrictions, please let us know when you book your reservation.
